The Pool

- Swim lengths, or play with your kids, while our lifeguards keep everyone in our 20-metre heated pool safe.
- Sunbathe or relax under the shade trees.
- Visit the adjoining courtyard to read, snack, or sip a drink.



Tennis

- Our two clay surface courts are regulation-sized and shielded from the wind.
- Courts are oriented north to south, which keeps the sun out of your eyes - making for great games all day long.
- Join in the doubles Round Robins; then lunch at the clubhouse or cool off in the pool.

Children's Areas

- There's plenty of space for children to be free and safe. We let kids be kids.
- Extend from the pool to the activities building
- Include an enclosed playground and extend to the Children's Summer Camp (our sailing camp has a 50-year history).
- Develop an appreciation of nature, awareness of weather, and respect for the lake.

There is no formal mailing address for our tender dock; however, the following will allow you to locate our docks easily.

- * Located on Queens Quay West, between Rees Road South and Lower Spadina Road.
- * Located on the south side of Queens Quay West.
- * You will see a Blue & White Island Yacht Club Ferry sign located at the southwest end of the bridge, directly above a set of stairs leading down to a lower level.
- * The Tender/Ferry docks are concrete docks, located on the lower level.
- * Landmarks: East - directly beside is the Marine Fire Station; West - parkland area; North - The Beer Store & Shoppers Drug Mart.
